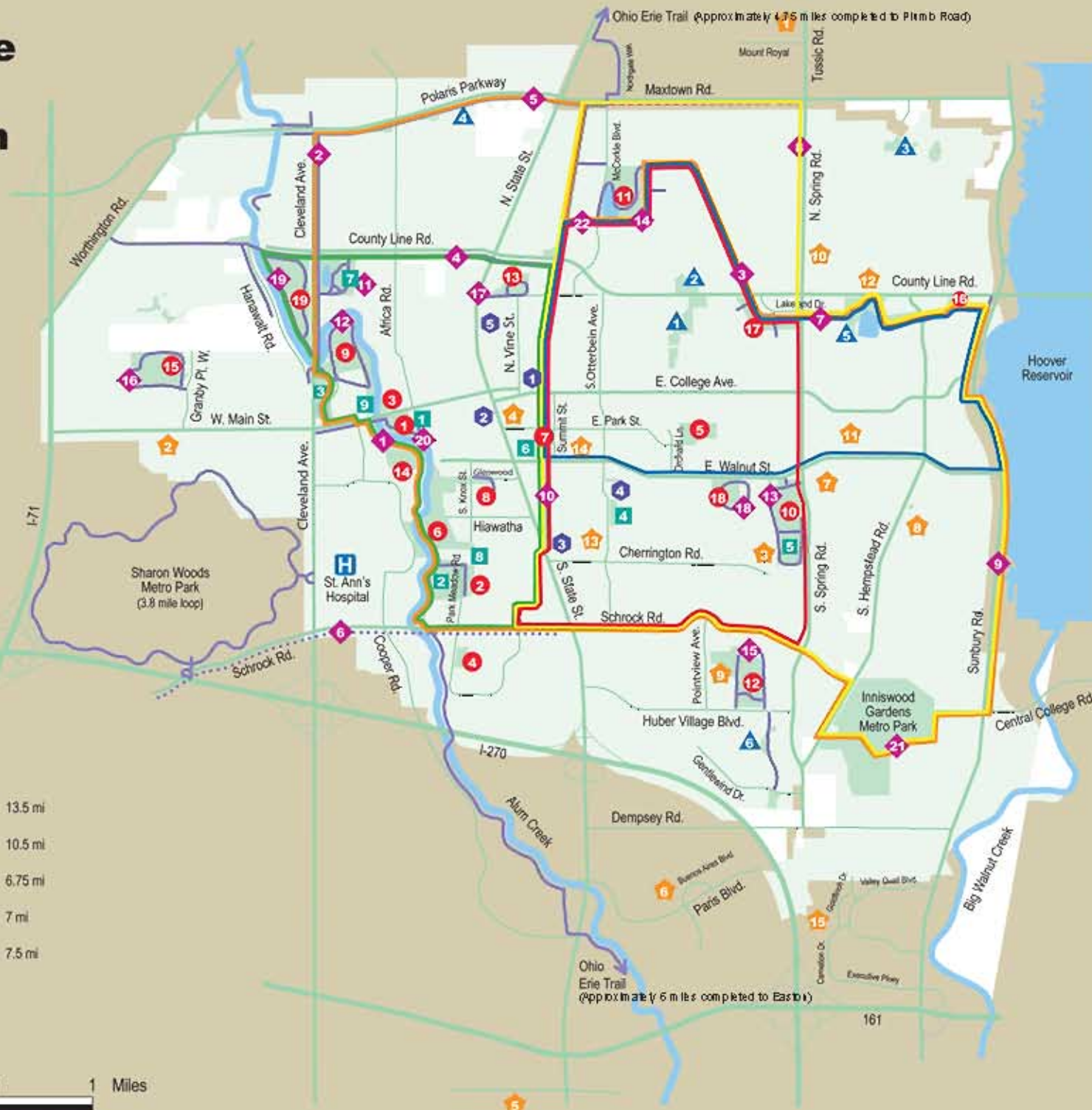
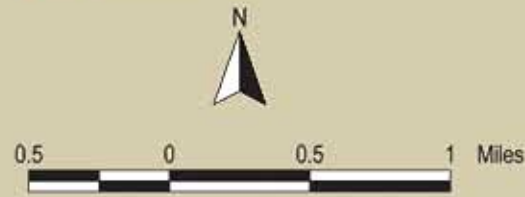

The Ohio to Erie Trail spans the State of Ohio from Cincinnati to Cleveland following lands formerly owned by railroads and canals. When complete, this trail will connect four of Ohio's metropolitan cities, a dozen large towns and numerous small villages.

Once the Ohio to Erie Trail is in place, users will be able to travel the corridor linking Cincinnati, Columbus, Akron and Cleveland on a safe trail while enjoying the splendor of Ohio's rural heartland.

Many sections of the Ohio to Erie Trail are open and in daily use, including Westerville's portion of the trail. Of the 453-mile length of the Ohio to Erie Trail, 262 miles are completed and open for public enjoyment, another 54 miles are either under construction or in engineering design, and an additional 137 miles are awaiting final planning, acquisition, and funding. CITY OF WESTERVILLE PARK RULES

Parks are open during daylight hours only unless otherwise posted. Overnight parking of vehicles and vehicles marked "For Sale" are prohibited. Only motorized vehicles registered with the BMV shall operate on Park streets or roadways. Please observe 15 MPH speed limit. Skateboards/In-Line Skating/Scooter allowed on path system and in designated Park areas only. Alcohol and drug use possession or intoxication are prohibited. Only leashed dogs and cats allowed in the Parks, scoop law strictly enforced. Illegal, inappropriate, and destructive conduct are prohibited. Noise shall not interfere with other patrons of the park and shall stay within park user's limits. To exhibit or formally entertain requires permission from the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department. Solicitation and events/programs for private gain are prohibited. Abide by Concealed Carry State guidelines. Abide by posted Lightning Prediction alert guidelines. Field permits are required for all organized play.

BIKEWAY/LEISURE PATH RULES

Abide by all signage. Yield to cross traffic at intersections. Keep right except to pass. Announce passing. Avoid blocking trail. Respect others and private property. Pets must be leashed/Obey scoop law. Users shall observe a fifteen (15) miles per hour speed limit on all Park Trails.
