##### **Westerville Champions**

The Champions of Westerville Recognition Program provides recognition of these outstanding individuals, for their service and contributions to the City, State, and/or Nation. Outstanding people will be recognized on a plaque located in the entry plaza to the Community Center, or by planting a tree with plaque along the park system pathways. The plaques will provide a brief overview of their achievements and contributions made to the Westerville Community. Many people have been recognized previously in a variety of ways. Those means will continue to serve as the recognition for these people. Recognition of future Champions will occur through the placement of a plaque in the entry plaza to the Community Center or the planting of a tree and plaque along the leisure paths in the parks

1. The person has served as a community role model and demonstrated exemplary leadership to the Westerville community.
2. The person's innovation, stewardship, integrity, and community engagement changed forever the way of doing things.
3. The person has made a lasting impression over time on the community and possesses significance for future generations.
4. The person has significantly changed Westerville's local history and improved the quality of life for Westerville residents.
5. The person was a resident of Westerville at the time of their major accomplishments.
6. The person nominated must be an individual. Groups and organizations may not be nominated as a Westerville Champion.
7. The City maintains the right to remove the recognition as it deems necessary.
