### Sebastian Coldiron Dies At Home Sat.

Services were held Monday for Sebastian H. Coldiron, 73, of 43 E. Park St. A veteran of the Spanish American War and World War I, he died Saturday at his home following a long illness.

Mr. Coldiron who retired from the U.S. Army March 3, 1924 was superintendent of subsistence for the Ohio Penitentiary from 1927 until his retirement in 1947.

He entered Military Services in 1901 and served with the 10<sup>th</sup> infantry division until his discharge. He was a first sergeant at the time of his discharge.

A member of the Westerville Methodist Church, he was also a 32<sup>nd</sup> degree Mason.

Survivors included; his wife, Mrs. Shella Coldiron, a daughter, Miss Marjorie Coldiron of the home; a son Mark of Toledo; two brothers, James of Cincinnati, and Clarence of Wheelersburg, and three sisters, Mrs. Gertrude Salyers of Lucasville, Bertha Dodge and Mrs. Vina Farley of Miami, Florida.

Rev. Thomas Adshead officiated at the service.

Interment was in Otterbein Cemetery by the Moreland Funeral Home. Military services were held at the cemetery.
