PIONEER DIES

**Mrs. Susan V. Osborn Resident
Of Blendon Many Years.**

Mrs. Susan Vincent Osborn, widow of Ralph Osborn, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. W. I. Taggert, at Linden Heights Friday morning at two o'clock. Mrs. Osborn was 79 years and eight months old. She had been ill for some months of a lingering disease. Her husband, Ralph Osborn was a well-known pioneer, who died Nov. 16, 1906.

Mrs. Osborn is survived by four daughters and four sons, Miss Nettie of Washington, D. C.; Hiram M. of Madison, Ala.; George. C., Emporia, Kans.; Clarence B. of Columbus; Mrs. Louis Agler of Linden Heights; John R. of Westerville; Mrs. Abbie Taggert of Linden Heights; and Mrs. Nellie Neiswander of Columbus. She is also survived by sixteen grandchildren.
