**Descendent of Pioneer
Family Spent Entire
Life Here**

Death came Sunday to Miss Ellen Jamison, at the home on the Three C highway, about a mile south of town, where she has resided for the past 71 years. Rev. Thomas Kahr conducted the funeral services which were held Tuesday afternoon at her late residence which she had shared with her sister, Miss Martha Jamison. Burial was made in Jamison cemetery, adjacent to the home, by G. W. Stockdale & Son.

Miss Jamison had been ill but a week when her death occurred. For many years she has been active in the affairs of Blendon (*illeg*). She is one of the oldest members of that organization, her membership being regular for the past 50 years, and has served as master and as chaplain for the past several years.

The deceased was a descendent of one of the pioneer families of this district. Her father at one time built and operated a tannery near the site where she spent her life.
