AGED RESIDENT

**Of Franklin County Dies Saturday at
Home of Nephew.**

Miss Mary Ann Cooper died at the home of her nephew, F. P. Dill, Saturday from infirmities of age, being 88 year, 4 months and 24 days old. Her entire life was lived on the same farm, she being born in one of the pioneer houses west of the railroad. For a number of years she made her home with Mr. Dill where she resided at the time of her death. She was an aunt of Messrs. F. P., J. A. and W. C. Dill and Mrs. Marcella Gould of Prospect, who were her nearest surviving relatives. Abraham Cooper of Westerville is a cousin.

The funeral was held from the late home Monday at 9:30, the services being in charge of Rev. L. H. Shane and Rev. Thomas Kohr. Burial was made in Jamison cemetery.

Obituary

Miss Mary Ann Cooper, daughter of John and Polly Cooper was born March 5, 1823, and died July 29, 1911, in her 89th year. She was born, reared, lived and died on this farm, and lived in this home fifty-six years.

She united with the Presbyterian church in early life and was faithful to all its obligations till death. She rarely missed a church service till failing health made attendance impossible. Her interest in the community was deep and active. Several years ago her neighbors formed the Mary Cooper club whose object was the improvement of the highway on which she lived, and the promotion of other neighborhood interests.

Miss Cooper is survived by F. P. Dill, whom she reared and with whom she lived, Crawford and James A. Dill and Mrs. Marcella Dill Gould all of Blendon township, and a number of relatives in Franklin county.
