(Westerville, Ohio) – **UPDATE:** The Westerville Division of Police has announced the arrest of four suspects, including three associated with an aggravated robbery at the Subway restaurant (495 S. State St.) around 9:30 p.m., connected to recent robberies of eight businesses in Westerville, Columbus and Blendon Township.

Investigators identified a fourth suspect, **Dylan Joseph Teegarden**, (DOB 10/22/91) of Westerville. The Delaware County Tactical Unit served a search warrant at 168 Cherokee in Westerville early Wednesday morning, February 6 and he was taken into custody without incident.

On Tuesday night, **Jay R. Coplen** (DOB 12/7/93), **Jack P. Coplen** (DOB 12/7/93) and **Chelsie N. Kennedy** (DOB 12/25/85) were arrested for the aggravated robbery at Subway. All four individuals are connected to eight robberies (listed below) in Westerville, Columbus and Blendon Township.

- Speedway Gas Station (S. State St., Westerville)
- BP Gas Stations (S. State St., Westerville, Sancus and Campusview [2 robberies])
- UDF (Sancus and Campusview)
- Yogi's Hoagies (S. State St.)
- Subway (S. State St.)
- Clark Gas Station (Route 3 at Paris Blvd [Blendon Township])

Westerville Police thank other jurisdictions involved in the investigation, including the Delaware County Sheriff's Office, Delaware Police Department, Genoa Township Police Department, Powell Police Department, Blendon Township Police Department, the Columbus Division of Police and the Bureau of Criminal Intelligence and Identification.
