FRANK P. DILL DIES

AT AGE OF 83 YEARS

Frank P. Dill, aged 83 years, died Thursday at his home, S. State road, located on the farm first settled by his maternal grandfather, known for a long time as the Cooper farm. Mr. Dill had been a life-long resident here and was active in many organizations in the town. He was a charter member of the Blendon Grange, and at the time of his death was an honorary member; had belonged to the Odd Fellows for sixty-one years, and was a member of the Knights of Pythias, the Masonic lodge and Scottish Rite.

The funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at the home, with burial in Pioneer Cemetery, which had been a part of his farm. Rev. J. Chester White, pastor of the Presbyterian church, where he had been a member since a young man, conducted the services. Geo. W. Stockdale & Son were in charge of burial. His wife Mrs. Etta Dill survives, as well as a number of nieces and nephews in this locality.
