(Westerville, OH) – The Westerville Division of Police has arrested Troy D. Cockrell, 51, deputy fiscal officer of the Westerville Public Library for embezzling funds. Cockrell has been charged with a fourth degree felony and is currently in Franklin County Jail.

Investigators believe Cockrell is responsible for cash thefts that may exceed \$20,000 in accounts from book fines, the coffee shop and coin-operated machines. Monies have not been reported missing from other funds, including taxpayer-funded accounts. At this point, thefts appear to date back as far as 2011. Investigators will further examine Cockrell’s 11-year history in the fiscal office at the Library.

Cockrell has been placed on unpaid administrative leave.
