(Westerville, OH) – Westerville Police have identified a person of interest related to a school shooting threat posted to social media on Wednesday, December 10.

The investigation continues in response to an anonymous post on the social media site Whisper. It read “I think I gonna shoot up my high school tomorrow.” Although no reference was made to a specific school or school district, the geotag indicated the person was in the Westerville area at the time of post.

Police have interviewed a student at a Westerville high school. The student has been released to a parent and the incident is still under investigation.
