(Westerville, OH) – Westerville Police have made an arrest related to a series of armed robberies of pharmacies in and around the Westerville area.

Jeffrey T. Young, 49, and Aaron J. Young, 22, both of 8929 Loudon St., Johnstown, were arrested Friday evening as suspects in robberies in February and March at three locations in the region.

Investigators believe both men were involved in each robbery, with one approaching the pharmacy counter and passing a note demanding prescription pills. In each robbery, a weapon was observed or implied during the robbery.

The investigation and subsequent arrest was made in conjunction with Blendon Township Police Department, Columbus Division of Police, Delaware County Drug Task Force, Licking County Sheriff's Office, Central Ohio Drug Task Force and other local law enforcement agencies.
