### WESTERVILLE POLICE TO “FILL-A-CRUISER” FOR FAMILIES IN NEED

The Westerville Division of Police will host the second-annual Holiday Fill-A-Cruiser on Saturday, December 19 from 9 a.m. - 12 p.m. at two Westerville-area grocery stores. At these locations, WPD cruisers will be parked on-site for donations to help families in need during the holiday season.

WPD has partnered with WARM (Westerville Area Resource Ministry) to accept and distribute donations. Last year, Fill-A-Cruiser collected more than 900 lbs. of food to the local charitable organization.

WARM provides assistance to individuals in the Westerville area who are living at 200% or below federal poverty guidelines. In addition to providing food and limited financial assistance to families in need, WARM offers a number of programs focused on providing individuals with tools to promote family stability, improve self-esteem and increase self-sufficiency.
