UPTOWN IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

UPTOWN SANITARY SEWER MAINS & SERVICE MAINTENANCE

Before the Uptown Improvement Project can officially begin, the City must conduct maintenance to sanitary sewer mains and service laterals.

The maintenance of these laterals normally falls at the expense of the property owners. However, because City engineers have determined that some sanitary sewer laterals in Uptown are in a state of disrepair, and we wish to avoid any future maintenance that may damage the new streetscape, the City will perform preventative maintenance at no cost to the property owner or tenant as a part of the Uptown Improvement Project.

This maintenance will ensure that sanitary sewers are up-to-date and reliable for Uptown businesses, avoiding any surprise problems in the future. This work will require coordination between the City, contractors and property/business owners. Work will be done in three phases:

1. **Mainline Cleaning** work will occur during overnight hours. Only minor traffic impacts are expected.
2. **Dye Testing** of service connections. This allows for thorough inspection of laterals and connection points. Traffic will be impacted from lane closures to allow the camera equipment to be set up in a safe manner. This work will be conducted during the day and will require some traffic pattern shifts.
3. **Complete lining process** during overnight hours. Only minor traffic and parking impacts are expected.

This work will temporarily reduce the ability of the main to accept sewage from specific properties, so limiting water usage during these overnight hours will help ensure there are no adverse impacts. Every effort will be made to minimize inconvenience to business owners and residents as much as possible. The entire project is expected to be complete in early May.
