Dear Uptown Stakeholder

The City of Westerville is committed to the ongoing improvements of critical infrastructure ahead of the Uptown Improvement Project, this includes the sanitary sewer mains and service laterals. Granite Inliner will resume work on Thursday, May 13. **In order to make these improvements, sewer services to your home or business will have limited service on the nights of June 13 to June 20.**

Careful steps have been taken to minimize disruptions to Uptown homes and businesses; however, we need your assistance in ensuring the success of this project. Please avoid the following activities from 9 p.m. - 6 p.m. June 13 – June 20.

- Showers and baths
- Washing dishes
- Washing clothes
- Excessive toilet usage

Sunday, June 16	State Street from Winter Street to Main Street
Monday, June 17	State Street from Main Street to Home Street
Tuesday, June 18	State Street from Park Street to Winter Street
Wednesday, June 19	State Street from Plum Street to Park Street

Conducting the above activities during the stated times could result in water and sanitary sewage backing up into your business or place of residence.

On rare occasions during the installation process, a distinctive resin-like odor may be detected. This odor is noticeable even at very low levels. The odor will dissipate with exposure to fresh air and there are no residual residue effects. This odor typically enters via a trap that is void of water or a plumbing defect. Please fill all drains, especially those that don't get used often, with a bucket of water. This will prevent the odor from entering your home or business.
