**E. J. NORRIS, BUSINESSMAN  
FOR 38 YEARS, DIES AT GRANT**

E. J. Norris, 59 W. College Ave., died Wednesday morning in Grant Hospital where he was taken last Friday.

He had been in failing health for some time suffering a heart condition.
